Economic and Community Development

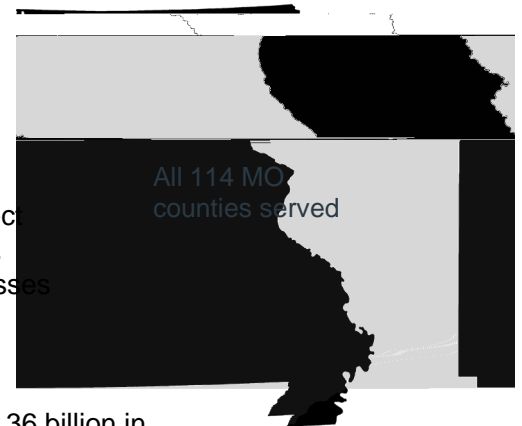
Generated more than \$6.5 billion in economic impact for the state in FY21, which represents direct spending in Missouri (\$2.5B) and indirect spending occurring as a result of the presence of UM System (\$4.0B).

In 2020, Business Development Specialists worked with small businesses and entrepreneurs statewide to create or retain 60,569 jobs.

UM System was issued 31 patents and filed 63 new U.S. patent applications in FY22.

Between FY16 and FY21, UM System brought Missouri more than \$1.36 billion in federal and private research funds, funded primarily from outside the state, but spent within the state.

MOREnet (Missouri Research and Education Network) provides internet connectivity, access, support and training to 58 higher education institutions (239,000 students), 487 K-12 school districts (827,000 students) and 135 public libraries (serving nearly 3 million Missourians) in 2021.
